Exhibition: *Recovery Happens 2022: We CAN Recover, We WILL Recover*

Is open to individuals in the Recovery Community to bring greater awareness of the importance of Recovery and treatment in our communities, the San Mateo County 'Recovery Happens' Planning Committee encourages you to submit recovery themed artwork (or artwork on any topic that meets criteria described below) created by people in recovery or who support recovery.

Show Dates: **September 1, 2022 - September 30, 2022**

Artwork will be displayed virtually at www.vorsmc.org/art as well as an in-person viewing at the Caldwell Gallery, 400 County Center. Redwood City, CA.

Submission Criteria: Only **ONE** wall-hung artwork per artist will be accepted (unless space permits), Artists submitting to the virtual art show may submit more than one piece if it meets the following criteria for eligibility:

- Minimum size of finished work is 16'' including frame on any one side, with a maximum of 36'' with frame (Maximum depth is 3'' and maximum weight is 30lbs per piece); There is some flexibility with size, so please inquire if your piece is larger or smaller.
- Artist signs a release of liability (Required)
- Works are wired for hanging (NO saw tooth hangers)
- No images of nudity, religion, politics or violence are allowed due to the nature of public business conducted at County Center
- Artist provides an optional brief statement (maximum 30 words) about the entry
- Artist provides label information including: artist name, art title, medium and price (or NFS) for work entered, by email to both Curator Shawna Ahern at curator@smcgov.org and Veronica Antonelli at info@vorsmc.org

Entry: **We are accepting entries as of 7/25/22 deadline for submission is 8/22/22**
